1. Optimisation of the Language of Instruction Policy

To further enhance students' proficiency in English and facilitate their transition to the new senior secondary curriculum and university education, our school is committed to promoting English as a medium of instruction, providing students with more opportunities to engage with the language.

In alignment with the Education Bureau's "Fine-Tuning of the Medium of Instruction Policy," our school adopts a gradual and progressive approach to English-medium teaching in non-language subjects at the junior secondary level. This approach takes into account the nature of each subject and students' learning abilities, utilising subject-based, class-based and group-based arrangements. Such flexibility aims to steadily improve students' English language skills, laying a solid foundation for their future academic pursuits.

In the 2026-2027 academic year, the school will establish an English-medium instructional group at the Secondary 1 level. In this group, in addition to English Language, subjects such as Science and Geography will also be taught entirely in English. This policy will further strengthen students' English proficiency, preparing them to meet future academic challenges and connect with the global community.

2. Igniting Learning Motivation: Leveraging Technology and Diverse Strategies

The school is dedicated to enhancing students' learning motivation and effectiveness through various initiatives:

These initiatives empower students to embrace a global perspective, develop exceptional cross-cultural communication skills, and lay a solid foundation for future international development.

- ✧ **We highly value our collaborations with sister schools in Mainland China, such as Guangzhou Pui Ying Secondary School, to foster meaningful cultural exchange activities.**
- ✧ **We actively encourage participation in Greater Bay Area and international competitions to strengthen students' competitiveness and boost their self-confidence.**
- ✧ **We offer overseas study tours, such as the Cambridge Study Tour in the UK, to expose students to global advancements and broaden their horizons.**

Besides, parents who have registered as SSPA e-Platform users with “iAM Smart+” may submit the applications for DP allocation.

Copies of the applicant's Primary 5 and Primary 6 academic reports. If the Primary 6 academic reports have not yet been issued, they can be submitted to the school office at a later date. 3. Copies of other achievement certificates (e.g., community services, extracurricular activities, or other learning experiences). 4. A copy of the applicant's identification document (e.g., HKID Card). 5. A self-addressed stamped envelope. Note: To avoid placing an additional burden on primary schools, it is not necessary to submit any recommendation letters.
